Guidelines

The grant will be open to interns, volunteers, and staff of HLPC member organizations only. Grants will be awarded based on the quality of the written proposal, which should include:

- A brief explanation of which conference you wish to attend and why
- Including a list of workshops & sessions you will be attending &
- How this will benefit your career and organization.

The proposal should be no more than 250 words. Remuneration of grant funds will require 2 minute / 1 slide report by the attendee of skills, lessons, or other benefits gained at the February Annual Meeting. Please include proof of conference attendance, such as photographs or conference session & workshop notes.

Letters of support are not required but may be submitted. Self-nomination and posthumous awards are allowed.

- Events
- Special Projects/Collaboration
